Intro

- Overview of your topic
- Intellectual Context: Your primary source and critical lens
- Thesis: The main argument guiding your paper

Body

- **Topic Sentence**: What idea is this paragraph going to cover?
- Context/Transition: Direct the reader to the specific scene or aspect you're discussing
- Evidence: A quote introduced with a signal phrase
- Analysis: Connection of evidence to your thesis. NOT summary but rather introducing your own ideas
- Outro Sentence: Reiterate the paragraph's idea and transition into your next paragraph

Outro

- Reiterate your thesis
- Reiterate your main body paragraph points
- **Zoom Out:** How does your topic relate to the world around you?
